It is a museum exclusively centred on the **83rd American Infantry Division** which liberated the small village of Bihain during the Second World War, January 10, 1945.

The course of this division is traced in a reconstructed decoration, punctuated by photos of Tony Vaccaro, soldier reporter in this division. You can also visit a wagon that was used for the deportation of Jewish prisoners to concentration camps
