**Yes, 3! This former rail track links Aix-la-Chapelle in Germany to Troisvierges in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg via the Eastern Cantons in Belgium.**

This green belt offers a wonderful way to discover the border regions and enjoy their natural landscapes. Its very light incline (2% max) makes it perfect for the whole family.

Along the way, you will enjoy the beauty of the German countryside, the stunning landscapes of the Hautes Fagnes and the forests and bocages of the Our valley and Duchy of Luxembourg.
