A real gem

Look out for...

- The 18th century Church of the Nativity (a listed, beautifully restored building) and its stunning furniture
- The presbytery
- The 17th century barn where taxes used to be paid
- the former site of the Baudart Brewery
- The Haute Bise villa, designed by Victor Horta

A 2.5 km trail will guide you through the village.

The nature reserve

The Montagne de Sosoye (also known as Ranzinelle) enjoys a remarkable natural heritage. Take a stroll there to admire its rich flora and rare plants.

A gourmet treat

For a drink or a delicious meal, stop at [Les Montagnards](#), a charming tavern/restaurant serving terroir inspired dishes.

Near the village

- Visit [the Maredsous Abbey](#) and taste the delicious treats made on site
- The site is crossed by the old Tamines-Dinant railway line, but all you hear nowadays is the gentle rattle of [rail bikes](#) (*'draisines'*) which enable many visitors to admire the rare beauty of this valley.
- Discover the ruins of [the Château de Montaigle](#), listed as exceptional cultural heritage of Wallonia
