The 7 stages of the Transardennaise

- La Roche-en-Ardenne - Sprimont (Sainte-Ode): 21 km
- Sprimont (Sainte-Ode) - Saint-Hubert: 21 km
- Saint-Hubert - Nassogne: 27 km

- Nassogne - Mirwart: 17 km
- Mirwart - Daverdisse: 22 km
- Daverdisse - Paliseul: 21 km or Mont-Idée: 25 km
- Paliseul - Bouillon: 26 km or Mont-Idée-Bouillon: 18 km

The itinerary has also been adapted for bikes/mountain bikes, motorbikes and cars.
